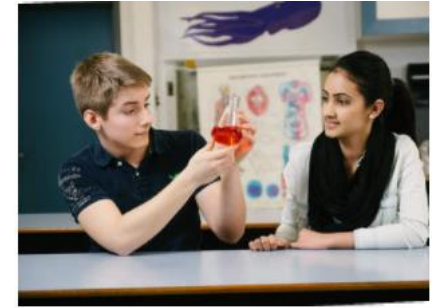


2022 Summer School Grade 9 to 12

The Abbotsford School District's Summer School program offers full credit courses to students who have not taken a course before, whose percentage level was below the recommended level of success, or who wish to receive advance credit.

Due to the condensed and intensive nature of summer school, **attendance at all 19 days of summer school is mandatory. Failure to attend may lead to removal from the course.**

Academic Summer School is open to all students currently in Grade 9 or higher.

Tuition / Fees

Existing and eligible, non-international students are not required to pay a fee.

International Student Fees: \$1,100
(per course)

Tuition / Fees can be paid using the school district's SchoolCashOnline portal.

Course Offered

Grade 9 – Math

Grade 10 – Career-Life Education, Literary Studies and New Media (English), Foundations of Math and Pre-Calculus, Science, and Social Studies

Grade 11 – Literary Studies (English), New Media (English), Foundations of Math, Pre-Calculus Math, Chemistry, Life Science, Physics

Grade 12 – English First Peoples, Pre-Calculus Math, Anatomy and Physiology (Biology), Chemistry, Physics, B.C. First Peoples, and Social Justice

Grade 9 Opportunities

This year we are offering Math 9; however, this course is only available to current grade 9 students. Grade 8 students are not eligible for registration.
