The Abbotsford School District's Summer School program offers full credit courses to students who have not taken a course before, whose percentage level was below the recommended level of success, or who wish to receive advance credit.

Due to the condensed and intensive nature of summer school, *attendance at all 19 days of summer school is mandatory. Failure to attend may lead to removal from the course.* 

Academic Summer School is open to all students currently in Grade 9 or higher.

### **Tuition / Fees**

*Existing and eligible, non-international students are not required to pay a fee.* 

International Student Fees: \$1,100 (per course)
